- Biddeford, Freeport, Saco, Scarborough, and South Portland have paid their PY2 dues
- PY1/FY23 budget finished with \$6,853.74 remaining. This amount will be added to the carry forward.

Legislative Update (Rebecca Graham-MMA)

- Session is ongoing, Rebecca will provide updates in September, including statewide stormwater funding
- Legislature is under lots of development pressures, want to reduce/remove fees, want to remove barriers
- Manufactured Homes bill (LR 1932?) to exempt stormwater and sewer fees died
- Closure date is September 29 for emergency bills

DEP Update (Holliday Keene, Kerem Gungor, Cody Obropta)

- **CCSWCD action item:** DEP needs a list of who is still waiting for PY9 annual report review comments
- Annual report template
 - o DEP is working on online report form but had technical and staffing delays, will have a trial period
 - ISWG comment: DEP online reporting form will need to be able to attach files
 - o **DEP action item:** Holliday will provide annual report memo
 - Holliday recommended EPA template for NH and MA or using previous permit's report template but EPA templates are specific to each permit year
- LID ordinance appeal hearing with BEP is tentatively scheduled for early October
- Chapter 500
 - Started process internally in December, stakeholder process is delayed due to Commissioner's requirement for a facilitator, Kerem & team are reviewing RFP applicants now

- New timeline: Select facilitator and bring them up to speed, reviewed LID ordinance white paper, want to invite in subject experts before stakeholder meetings start early November, Chap 500 subscriber list will start receiving bulletin updates, want to have final rule by Fall 2025
 - ISWG members would like Kerem at the BEP LID ordinance appeal to help align BEP decision with Chap 500

 - Having issues contacting permittees as contact information fluctuates and no easy way to update
 - o Updated 5-year recertification form, requiring photo report with inspections
